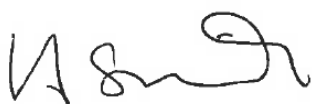

LE-005BPSB Arrest

Pursuant to *Ontario Regulation 392/23 - Adequate and Effective Policing (General) – Law Enforcement* it is the policy of the Belleville Police Service Board with respect to arrest that the Chief of Police will:

1. Establish and maintain written procedures on arrest that require the compliance by members of the Belleville Police Service with the legal, constitutional, and case law requirements relating to arrest;
2. Ensure that Officers, and other Members as appropriate, are kept informed of changes in the law relating to arrest;
3. Ensure Members shall not, by act or omission, do anything that the Officer at the time, knows or reasonably ought to know would infringe or deny a person's rights or freedoms under the *Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms*; and
4. Ensure Members shall not in the course of their duties, treat any person in a manner that the Officer, at the time, knows or reasonably ought to know would contravene the *Human Rights Code*.
